As for the blend itself, it is made up of casks of malt whisky from some of the most prestigious distilleries in Scotland, and rare old grains, all carefully selected by our Chairman Euan C. Shand. They have been matured for a minimum of thirty years, culminating in a rare premium blend laden with rich fruit cake topped with almonds and subtle spices.



TASTING NOTES

Colour - Antique Gold.

Nose - Rich fruit cake topped with almonds.

Scented hints of rose.

Palate - Beautifully balanced with warming Christmas spices and a cocktail of citrus fruits.

Finish - Evocative, dried fruits to the forefront with a subtle spicy background.
